Improvisational Quilting



You can use my quilt as inspiration or come with an idea of your own. In either case, you will find that your quilt will take shape as you cut and sew.

Fabric

Bring a variety of fabrics in the colors that you want to work with.

- Fat quarters are a good size to work with.
- Scraps of accent fabric may come in handy.
- There is a fine line between having too much and too little fabric. A variety of fabrics that total at least 3 yards but not more than 5 yards ought to be enough to give you options as you work.

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Something suitable for a design wall and a way to hang it.
- A sewing machine in good working order that ***you know how to use***. You don't need your biggest, most expensive machine.
- An extension cord and/or power strip.
- A rotary cutting mat
- 6" x 12" or larger ruler
- A rotary cutter
- Bring suitable thread to use for piecing in color(s) that work with your fabric. You will find it handy to have an iron and pressing mat if it is allowed by the venue.
- Small, sharp fabric scissors
- Bring pins for both piecing and to use on the design wall.
