Practical Color For Quilters



This is a fun, **no-sew** day filled with surprises and lots of discussion. You will play with color and value as you glue fabric to paper to make pieced blocks. Everyone puts their blocks together and we all get to see what works, what doesn't, and most importantly, how to make color work for you.

This class is suitable for all skill levels.

- Fabric: 6-10 (or more) 4" x 4" squares of each of the following colors:
 - blue
 - green
 - yellow
 - orange
 - red
 - purple
 - whites, light grays, beige/cream
 - blacks, dark grays, browns

Make sure that you have a variety of values, from light to dark. Feel free to include a few colors that you are not particularly in love with.

You are not likely to use all of your squares in class but the more you bring, the more choices you will have.

- A **small rotary mat, ruler, and cutter.**
- Paper:** Bring 36 - 4"x4" squares of either plain or graph paper. (TIP: You can cut 4 squares per 1 standard sheet of paper.)
- A **glue stick**
