

## Supply List

# Lawn and Garden



The pattern is provided in class. The photo shows four 11" x 11" finished size blocks.

**Fabric** *I recommend that you pre-wash all fabric before class.*

My quilt is made with cotton lawn which is a very fine cotton. You are welcome to use that or regular cotton off the bolt.

- Block background fabric:** 1 square 13" x 13"
- Applique fabrics:** A variety of large scraps in colors suitable for the block. You will only have time to sew 1 leaf and 1 or more petals in class so don't stress over your selections.

### **Additional Supplies**

- Small **paper scissors**
- Small **fabric scissors**
- One 11" x 11" square of medium weight **clear upholstery vinyl**. Keep any tissue paper that came with the vinyl.
- An **ultra fine point Sharpie** marker in black
- 1 sheet of clear, heavy weight, single-sided, self-adhesive laminate at [pieceocake.com](http://pieceocake.com) or an office supply store.
- I will supply you with a needle and a toothpick.
- Applique pins**. I recommend short pins.
- I will have Superior Masterpiece 50/2 100% cotton thread for you to sew with in class.
- General's charcoal pencil in white**.
- A blackwing 602 pencil, or a mechanical pencil with gray refills for light fabrics
- A **sandpaper board** or a sheet of fine grain sandpaper.
- A **baggie** for your templates
- A **light and an extension cord** in case the room is dark. Note that you may not be able to use this in some classrooms.

- Many people find that applique is easier if they have a **Lap App or pillow** in their lap to rest their forearms on. You can find Lap Apps at [pieceocake.com](http://pieceocake.com).
