

The Magical Unicorn

Supply List



Learn the art of straight-stitch machine applique as you work on this 15" x 15" portrait-sized block. This is a smaller version of Magical Unicorn quilt and a good size for class.

Fabric *I recommend that you pre-wash all fabric before class.*

White block base fabric: 1 square 18" x 18"

Applique fabrics:

Rainbow Stripes: 1 fat quarter each of red, orange, and yellow.

If you want to change the colors in your rainbow that is fine.

Sky: 8" x 8"

White for the Unicorn: 1 fat quarter

A variety of large scraps for the mane and horn.

Additional Supplies

- Paper scissors to use on the freezer paper templates
- Fabric scissors: I used both my longer scissors and my shears.
- One 15" x 15" square of medium weight **clear upholstery vinyl**. If the vinyl comes with tissue paper, cut it with the vinyl.
 - If you can't find upholstery vinyl, a clear heavy-weight shower curtain liner (Target or Walmart) can work but be aware that it may be a little stretchy and harder to handle.
- An ultra fine point Sharpie marker in black
- 1 small roll of freezer paper.
- Pins.
- A sandpaper board or a sheet of fine grain sandpaper.
- A Quilter's Select glue stick (yellow)
- Rotary cutting mat
- Rotary cutter
- 6" x 12" ruler
- A sewing machine in good repair *that you know how to use!*
- Bring an open-toe embroidery foot if you have one.
- Piecing thread

- ❑ Thread for machine applique - I use a 50/2 or 80/2 cotton
- ❑ Pins for piecing
- ❑ Seam ripper (just in case)
- ❑ An extension cord and surge protector with multiple outlets.
- ❑ A portable iron and mat. Note that in some venues you may not be able to use your iron.
- ❑ Optional: A portable design wall that you can pin into.
- ❑ Optional: You know what you like to have in class. It might be a chair, a cushion for the chair provided, or a light... whatever it may be, bring it with you.
- ❑ A gallon-size baggie for your templates
