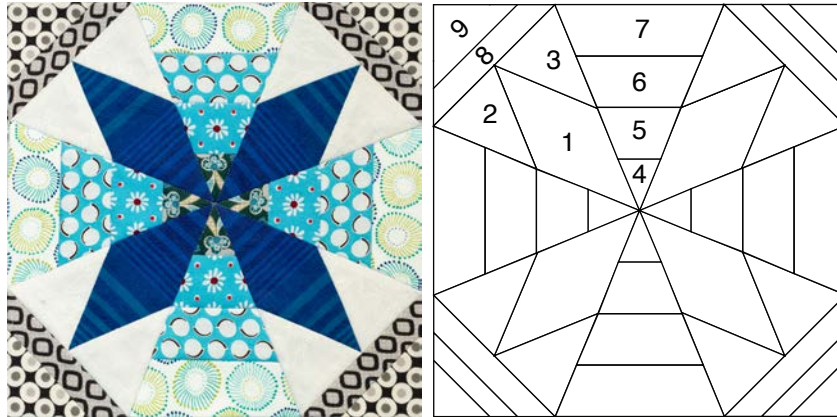


# Test Pattern

## Supply List



*The 16" x 16" finished size block pattern is provided in class.*

**Fabric for 1 Block** *I recommend that you pre-wash all fabric before class. Refer to the photo and diagram above as you choose the fabrics for your quilt.*

Choose large scraps of fabric for each of the following numbered shapes. A 12" x 12" square of each fabric should be plenty unless you fussy cut from a print with widely spaced motifs.

- #1— dark star points
- #2 and 3 — light background
- #4 — dark
- #5 — medium
- #6 — light-medium
- #7 — light
- #8 — contrast corner bands
- #9 — corners

### **Notions**

- Medium-sized paper scissors
- Medium-sized fabric scissors
- Quilter's Select or Sewline Glue Pen
- Mini (or small) Wonder Clips, you will only need 3 or 4 for class
- Needle(s): If you have a favorite needle, bring it with you. I will supply you with a needle to use in class. My favorite needles are the #10 Tulip embroidery needle, #9 Tulip piecing needle, and/or Sue Daley's #11 Milliners needles. Other needles also work.
- I will have Superior Masterpiece thread on pre-wound bobbins and some 80wt Aurifil cotton threads for you to sew with in class.
- A baggie for your pieces

### **Optional Notions**

- 1 or 2 SewTite Magnetic Pin Dots
- A light and an extension cord in case the room is dark. Note that you may not be able to use this in some classrooms.
- A small 'Lazy Susan'-style rotary mat is handy. If not that, a small rotary mat can also be helpful. If you are comfortable using a rotary cutter without a ruler, bring a small cutter with your mat.

- Many people find that hand sewing is easier if they have a Lap App or pillow to rest their forearms on. You can find Lap Apps at [pieceocake.com](http://pieceocake.com).
